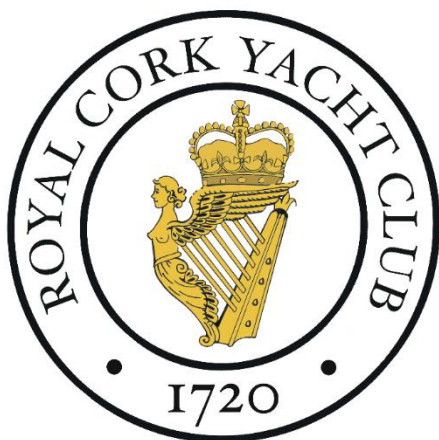
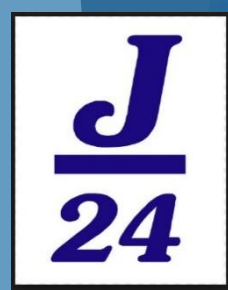

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1 RULES

1.1

This event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (“RRS”) 2013 - 2016.

1.2

The Irish Sailing Association prescriptions will apply.

1.3

The rules of the International J24 Class shall apply.

1.4

Where there is a conflict with the Notice of Race, the sailing instructions shall prevail except that neither shall change nor alter a class rule.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1

Advertising for the regatta shall follow RRS 80. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

2.2

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority as prescribed under Appendix.1 and International J24 Class Rule 24.

2.3

The OA reserves the right to refuse entry to the event if there is, in its opinion, a conflict of interest between a competitor’s sponsor and the event sponsor.

2.4

Any boat considering accepting or entering with sponsorship that might be affected by this rule is advised to contact the OA before entering.



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3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1

All competitors shall comply with ISAF Eligibility Rules (ISAF Regulation 19). The Regatta is open to boats registered with the International J24 Class, whose helm or registered owners are members of a National J24 Class Association recognised by the International J24 Class Association.

3.2

By June 12th 2015, Entries received after June 12th will be deemed as late entries.

3.3

The Entry Fee for this event is set at €100 and is non refundable

3.4

Any boat that wants to stay on and do Volvo Cork Week from the 10th to the 15th of July, will have their entry fee of €100 for the J24 Southern's discounted off their entry fee to Volvo Cork Week.

3.5

Late entries will be accepted up to and including July 02nd 2016 at the discretion of the OA and will be subject to a late entry fee of €30.

3.5 Launching

Craning in and berthing at the event is included in the entry fee. Please register with the event race office before going to the crane. The crane will be available from 1500 to 2100 on Friday 01st. Launching on Saturday 02nd will be available from 8.30 but only by appointment with the race office. Boat lift out is available on Sunday after racing.



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5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

Competitors may register at the RCYC Race Office from 1700 to 2000hrs on Friday 01st July

To comply with registration requirements, competitors must ensure the following:

- a. The signed entry form has been submitted in full and the entry fee is fully paid.
- b. Emergency contact names and telephone numbers are provided.
- c. Completion of safety checks as requested.

5.2

Boats that fail to complete their Registration shall be scored DSQ, without a hearing. This amends RRS 63.1.

5.3

It is proposed to sail six races. A minimum of three races must be sailed to constitute a series.

Proposed Schedule of Races:

Saturday 02nd of July 2016: Up to five races

Sunday 03rd of July 2016: Remaining races to complete series of six races. No race will be started after 1500 Sunday 03rd of July 2016, except for postponements, general recalls and abandonment of a race where the warning signal was made before 1500.

Regatta Briefing:

0900 Saturday 02nd of July 2016

Warning Signals:

1030 on Saturday 02nd of July 2016 and 1030 Sunday 03rd July 2016
Schedule of all subsequent races will be as directed in the Sailing Instructions.



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6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1

Each boat shall produce a valid Measurement Certificate where class rules require.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after June 12th 2015 from the Race Office and will be posted online.

8 VENUE

8.1.

Racing will take place in Cork Harbour and its surrounding waters. Refer to Admiralty charts 1777 and 1765.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1

Decisions of the protest committee jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5. (B)

11 SCORING

11.1

The Low Point Scoring System Rule A4 will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with her worst score/s discarded according to the table below. Rule A4 is amended to accommodate rule A5 and will be used even when a series is a Regatta. A minimum of three races will constitute a series. Discards applied based on races sailed

1, 2 or 3 races sailed no discard

4 or more races sailed 1 discard



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12 BERTHING

Designated Dinghy Park Spaces will be provided to competitors for the duration of the regatta. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the Royal Cork Yacht Club Dinghy Park at all times when ashore.

14 PRIZES

Overall class prizes/trophies will be awarded.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

The Safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat. He/She must ensure that the boat and her crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the Regatta. Neither the establishment of the required safety regulations nor the inspection of any boat in any way limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor for their crew, boat and the management thereof.

16 INSURANCE

It is the duty of each boat owner to have his boat adequately insured against any risk, including civil responsibility to third parties and to ensure that such insurance remains valid for the entirety of the event. All owners / competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owners / competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry

17 MEDIA WAIVER

Competitors give their consent to the Royal Cork Yacht Club, its sponsors, and the organising authority to use their name, comments, photograph and likeness in order to promote the event.

17 FACILITIES

Competitors are granted temporary membership of The Royal Cork Yacht Club from Friday 01st July 2016 to Sunday 03rd July 2016, subject only to the provisions of the Club Rules for withdrawing or withholding such membership. All competitors are invited to avail of the facilities of the Club during the event.

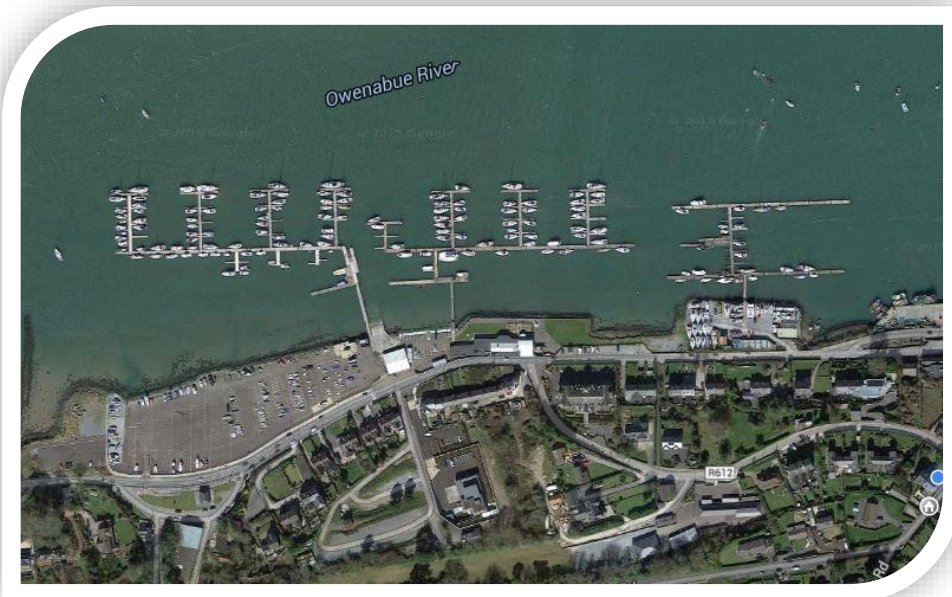
