1. Club Guidelines

Club guidelines have been updated. All Keelboat sailors / Boat owners & Keelboat Members are required to adhere to these guidelines.

2. New Contract Tracing Form

Keelboat & motorboat skippers are responsible from keeping a record of people in their 'pod' participating in activities on their boat and they must complete the contact tracing form each time they take to the water, racing or not. For those taking part in racing, the form must be completed within 30 minutes of completion of the final race to get a result.

3. Health Declaration

Health Declaration Forms must be completed when taking to the water. Unlike the contract tracing form, this is a once off requirement per member/sailor unless responses change.

4. Race Declarations – We need your 2020 Race Declaration & RCYC/SCORA Race Registration

The Keelboat Committee would ask you to please complete the 2020 Sailing declaration in advance to taking to the water. In line with General Sailing Instructions 2020, all Keelboats are required to complete 2020 Race Declaration. Failure to complete the same will result in no race results being provided to the offending boat.
