TY Programme 2020/2021

We have a packed full programme of activities planned for our TYs. This is the second year the Royal Cork Yacht Club has run such a programme. The programme is open to RCYC club members only.

SOME IMPORTANT POINTS OF NOTE IN RELATION TO THE PROGRAMME:

1. There are modules in the TY Programme.
2. A deposit of €100 is required to secure your place on the programme
3. Courses will have to be paid for on booking.
4. Please understand that deadlines must be observed. Once we reach a deadline date, we will book and commit to the necessary resources for those who have signed up to that course at that point.
5. Therefore, if you book and pay for a course and your son/daughter cannot attend we will not be in a position to offer a refund as we will have planned and budgeted to run courses on the basis of the committed bookings.
6. Similarly, because of the scale of the programme and the need to book resources there will be no option for late entries. However, there are multiple runnings of several modules so hopefully the sailor can be an early sign up to a subsequent course.
7. In some elements we have restrictions on numbers and courses will be allocated on a strictly first come first served basis.
8. The program will be offered on a first come first served basis, to RCYC club members only. It is being run in conjunction with the Royal Cork by volunteers. So, to that end please understand that the need to have clarity and structure for the benefit of all.
9. We are planning to deliver the full programme but do reserve the right to cancel elements at short notice pending advice in relation to Covid 19

At this stage, we are seeking expressions of interest for the planned activities to help us organise dates, coaches, pricing etc, so please help us by filling the expression of interest form with your choices.

NOTES

- Garda Vetting: Apply via Irish Sailing, valid for 3 years
- Checklick: sailor must make sure they are set up on Checklick
- Must be 17 to be a sailing instructor, can do the Instructor course within 6 months of 17th birthday
- Dinghy Instructor T & C's: Must be a minimum of 1 month between doing Pre Entry Course and Dinghy Instructor Course
