



NOTICE OF RACE

SCORA Dunmore RACE 2021

1. **Organising Authority.** The Organising Authority is Royal Cork Yacht Club.

2. Rules

- 2.1 Cruiser Class Racing will be governed by World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 - 2024 ("RRS"), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association ("ISA"), the IRC Rating Rule 2021, the rules of SCORA, the rules of ECHO, the Sailing Instructions ("SIs") of this race and any amendments thereto. In the event of a conflict, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 2.2 Each boat must have a minimum of two crew to qualify for entry (skipper and one other).

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 To be eligible to enter Royal Cork Yacht Club ("RCYC" or the "Club") Dunmore Race 2021, the owner and/or helm must be a member of a Yacht Club and the ISA. This amends RRS Appendix
- 3.2. All competitors shall be temporary members of Royal Cork Yacht Club for the duration of the race.
- 3.3 Cruiser Class Racing is open to all Cruisers, Racer/Cruisers and Cruiser/Racers only.
- 3.4 All yachts shall complete the online Registration Form [Online Registration Dunmore 2021](#)

- 3.4 To be eligible for IRC results yachts must hold in date valid certificates. Endorsed certificates are not required to be eligible for a result.
- 3.5 The Cork Harbour to Dunmore Race is an All In IRC and ECHO race – no class divisions apply.

4. Start

- 4.1 First Gun 07.00hrs on 21st August 2021 and it will be an All-in start in the vicinity of No3 and Roches
- 4.2 VHF 71 will be used for communicating on the day.

5. The course.

- 5.1 Start Cork Harbour – Finish Dunmore – please see Sailing Instructions for details on the finish line to include a map.

6. Time Limit

- 6.1 Latest finishing time 24.00hrs on Saturday 21st August 2021.

7. Insurance

- 7.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance for the duration of the league(s).

8. Scoring

- 8.1 The Low Point scoring system will apply. Results will be provided based on IRC & Echo
