Royal Cork Yacht Club (Sunday, September 18th)

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Racing will be governed by current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing. ISA Prescriptions and those of the ILCA Ireland.
- 1.3 The organising authority is the local club on the day of the regatta.

2. Eligibility, Fleets and Entry

- 2.1 Entry is open to all Laser sailors who are member of Irish Sailing Clubs.
- 2.2 All competitors will be deemed to be temporary members of the club of the day for the duration of the event and as such will be expected to abide by the rules of the club.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the required fee.

3. Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee for each event is €20. An entry fee of €50 will apply for entry to all three races in the tri-series.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The event will be held on August 7th at the Bantry Bay Sailing Club. Sunday September 4th at Inniscarra Sailing and Kayaking club and on September 18th at Royal Cork Yacht Club.
- 4.2 Five sprint races are scheduled for each event. (20-30 min race durations)
- 4.3 Registration: Competitors should register on the morning of Sunday 07th August in Bantry Bay Sailing Club. Sunday September 4th at Inniscarra Sailing and Kayaking club and on September 18th at Royal Cork Yacht Club between 1000 hours and 1100 hours.
- 4.4 Competitors Briefing is scheduled for 1100 hours on each event day. .
- 4.5 The first warning signal for all scheduled race day's will be made at 1155 hours. Subsequent races will follow as soon as is practicable.

5. Measurement and Sail Numbers

- 5.1 A boat or equipment may be measured at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions.
- 5.2 Boats shall use their correct sail numbers, which shall be clearly readable on both sides of the sail (also as per entry form listing).

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 The Sailing instructions will be available, at minimum, one week before each regatta starts online at www.royalcork.com/ilca-sprint-tri-series/

7. The Venue

- 7.1 Racing on August 7th will take place in Bantry harbour and its surrounding waters. There will be a designated race areas available using the inner harbour. Details of race areas will be outlined in more detail within the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2 Racing on September 4th will take place on Iniscarra Lake. There will be a designated Race area available. Details of race areas will be outlined in more detail within the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.3 Racing on September 18th will take place in Cork harbour. There will be numerous Race areas available using inside Cork Harbour. Details of race areas will be outlined in more detail within the Sailing Instructions.

8. The Courses

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The Low Point System will apply. For further details, see Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute an event.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Will be awarded as follows:-
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd, 1st Girl in Ilca 4 Fleet
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd, 1st Girl in Ilca 6 Fleet
 - Separate prizes will be award for the triserries winner in Ilca 4 and Ilca 6.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Insurance

- 12.1 It is the duty of each boat owner to have his boat adequately insured against any risk, including civil responsibility to third parties and to ensure that such insurance remains valid for the entirety of the triserries.
